OVERSEE BAY YOUTH

You'll be responsible for leading Bay Youth and overseeing all the youth work that we offer in and through Bay Church.

NOURISH THE FAITH OF OUR YOUNG PEOPLE

You'll be able to build up our existing Christian young people whilst enabling others to explore Christian faith for the first time.

EXPAND RELATIONSHIPS WITH SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY

You'll be able to establish and grow relationships with local schools to help you become a familiar face in the community. Which, in turn, will contribute to our wider outreach work with young people across the Bay.

You'll be encouraged to take responsibility for your own ongoing professional and theological development in ministry. We'll play our part in supporting and encouraging you to attend conferences and to engage with training and resources that build you up in your role.

As part of our front-line team, you'll contribute to the growth of our safeguarding practices and oversee the adoption of church policies within youth initiatives and crews; bringing a current understanding of Safeguarding, Health & Safety and GDPR best-practice to ensure the welfare of those around you.

You'll take responsibility for creating and managing the budgets for youth. You'll be expected to think strategically and explore ways to make the best use of the resources that will be entrusted to you.






ACTIVE MEMBER OF BAY CHURCH
